## Citizens,

**Planning and Zoning**-The city would like to remind citizens with the upcoming warm weather to be sure to get building permits for any and all structures, shed, fences, carports, etc. that you wish to erect. You may call the office for an application or visit our website to download one.

**Pet Licensing**-Dogs and cats within the city limits are required to be licensed with the city. The cost is minimal (\$5 for dogs, \$4 for cats). The fee, along with proof of vaccinations, can be turned in at the city office in exchange for your pet license. This helps the city office help lost pets make it back home safely, knowing where all dogs/cats reside.

**Township Hall**-The township hall now has a Wi-Fi hotspot for your use, and On Thursdays from 11:15-12:15, the Meriden/Ozawkie Library is conducting story time in the township hall.
