Approving the Agenda

Gary Branson made a motion to approve the agenda, Margie Payne Seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

a) 102 Cottonwood Building Application

Ed Benton presented an acceptable solution regarding the drainage problem. Kevin Klenklen wants a grate put in to stop soil runoff until the new lawn is done.

Motion was made by Gary Branson to approve the building application. Seconded by Kevin Klenklen the motion carried unanimously

b) 400 Sioux Water Meter Pit

No action has currently been taken. The estimated cost top bore under the street is between 1500-2000. Gary Branson would like the City to split the cost with the resident. Kevin Klenklen also suggest that the residents not have to pay their amount all at once.

Motion was made by Kevin Klenklen to pay half of the relocation of the water pit. Seconded by Margie Payne. Chris Feuerborn voted No. The motion carried 3-1.

c) Storm Drainage

Work on storm drainage project needs to start before the end of the year. There are 7 areas that cross residential property. FEMA will only help on City streets and Corp ground. Kevin Klenklen volunteers to take the lead on this project and finding an engineer.

d) New Dumpster

Mayor Lutes explained the different sizes of dumpsters and prices between 325-375 and the dumping schedule.

Motion was made by Gary Branson to get the biggest size dumpster at the burning pit. Seconded by Kevin Klenklen. The motion passed unanimously.
