

ORDINANCE NO. 21-1

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 15-203 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS UPDATING THE WATER SERVICE CONNECTION FEE WITHIN THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 15-203 of the Code of the City of Ozawkie, the Governing Body hereby establishes that the water connection and meter fee shall be \$2,000.00, plus any and all additional costs of installation incurred by City to make such connection. The fee schedule of the City of Ozawkie shall hereby be revised to reflect this increased fee.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All ordinances or parts or Sections of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City Newspaper.

Resolution No.21-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Ozawkie was calculated as 19.046 mills by the Jefferson County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Ozawkie will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 13, 2021 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Ozawkie, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OZAWKIE:

The City of Ozawkie shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 19.046 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
